

Why is registering to go on a run by booking tickets still required?

- Participants on the runs can be easily and quickly contacted individually by email should there be any last minute changes, mass emails via the Mailchimp system go to all registered members, and annoyingly can sometimes take a while to be approved by Iain Fleming or other members of the committee.
- So we know who is attending in advance
- Group rates generally will only be given on groups of 15 or more.
- So we can make arrangements enabling late arrivals to join us on route
- Most venues now require advance notice if more than 10 people are attending
- Meals and refreshments can be ordered in advance at the mid morning comfort stop and the final destination, reducing the time spent queueing.
